State Patrol Enforcement Memo Covering FMCSA Rule Limiting Hand-Held Phone Use By Commercial Vehicle Operators

The Minnesota State Patrol has issued an enforcement advisory memo detailing their handling of the implementation of the new Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration rule banning hand-held cell phone use by commercial vehicle operators. The FMCSA rule goes into effect on January 3. Warnings will be given to drivers found in violation of the rule for 90 days (until April 3). A copy of the State Patrol Enforcement Memo is attached.
