Make Transportation Job #1

Time is running out for Congress to pass a multi-year federal transportation bill that will invest in our nation's roads, bridges and transit systems before funding for those programs expires on March 31. To build momentum for passage of such a bill, AGC of America is leading a comprehensive grassroots campaign called Make Transportation Job #1. We strongly urge all members to help support this campaign, visit its website, www.agc.org/roads, and be sure to:

- (1) Send pre-written letters to your Representatives and Senators;
- (2) Sign a petition expressing your support for passing a highway and transit bill; and
- (3) Use a complete grassroots toolkit with sample letters to the editor and about arranging effective meetings with your Representatives and Senators.

Additionally, to further the campaign's success, we urge you to spread the word about the Make Transportation Job #1 campaign to your business colleagues - both inside and outside the construction industry - as well as your employees.

BIM Training in Duluth

Building Information Modeling (BIM) is changing the way projects are constructed. AGC of America has created the BIM Education Program, a four-part series designed to prepare general and specialty contractors to confidently implement BIM on projects. Completion of all four parts and successfully passing an assessment exam will result in a Certificate of Management – Building Information Modeling (CM-BIM). On **February 13**, we will offer part one of the series: BIM 101 – An Introduction to Building Information Modeling. Take just this introductory course to learn the essential concepts of BIM or plan to take the entire certificate program. Information about the complete CM-BIM program and a registration form for BIM 101 are attached. We have applied for CEU accreditation for this session from the USGBC and AIA.

BIM Units 2 - 4

We will be offering the remaining three units in the BIM Certificate of Management program at the AGC office on the following dates:

- February 28 and 29** – Technology (Unit 2)
- March 13** – Process, Adoption and Integration (Unit 4)
- March 27** – Contract Negotiation and Risk Allocation (Unit 3)

While all four units are required to sit for the certification exam, it is possible to take single units based on an individual's scope of responsibilities. Registration information is attached.
